- Submit your entry by email to hubcontest@kdh.on.ca or by dropping off at designated drop off locations (North Grenville District High School, St. Michaels' Catholic High School, Saint Marguerite Bourgeoys-Kemptville Pavilion, South Branch Public School, Leeds, Grenville and Lanark District Health Unit-Kemptville Service Site, Children's Mental Health of Leeds and Grenville-Kemptville Service Site, Kemptville District Hospital (main entrance lobby).
- No responsibility is assumed by Kemptville District Hospital and/or its employees for any disruption to telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers or providers, computer equipment, software or failure of any entry to be received because of technical problems on the internet or at any website, or any combination thereof, as well as lost, misdirected, or late entries which for any reason are not received or which are illegible, incomplete or irregular in anyway.
