

Emergency Room Kiosk Greeter/Ambassador

Primary Role:

Greet visitors arriving at the ER door and offer assistance; support patients and families during their time in the ER. Have a smile and don't wait for patients to come to you, try to anticipate needs when possible.

Key Responsibilities:

- Ask everyone to sanitize their hands and wear a mask while in KDH
- Assist patients arriving for the ER with getting a number for triage
- Assist patients arriving for an appointment to take a designated chair while waiting for patient registration (they do not take a number)
- Answer questions and assist patients and visitors with way finding
- Communicate with nursing staff as per protocol
- Offer a wheelchair, warm blanket, ice pack, tissues, etc., if appropriate
- Escort visiting family members into ER according to protocol
- Direct visiting family members for admitted patients to the upstairs nurses station
- Improve patient experience
- Assist with the use of the parking payment machine or contact parking attendant
- Replenish disposable supplies (tissues, masks, etc.) in the ER waiting area
- Retrieve wheelchairs from other areas of the hospital for use in the ER
- Run errands and assist staff as requested

Specifications:

- Responsible individual with a mature appreciation of confidentiality
- Strong communication skills and interpersonal skills
- Positive, caring and compassionate attitude
- Ability to remain calm and use sound judgment while working with people who may be suffering from high levels of stress
- High level of initiative and must be able to work independently
- Must be able to handle a busy environment
- Must have good knowledge of hospital layout
- Current Vulnerable Sector check required
- Keep Surge Learning (online training) up to date, annually

** Note: volunteers are not permitted to transfer patients from one surface to another



Volunteer Hand Hygiene Auditor

Primary Role:

Conduct hand hygiene audits within KDH under the direction of the Occupational Health/Infection Prevention & Control Practitioner.

Key Responsibilities:

- In a given area of the hospital, observe for a minimum of 20 minutes and record the results of instances when hand hygiene is required.
- Areas of the hospital to include the Emergency Room, the Medical In-Patients area, the Surgical In-Patients area and the Interim Long Term/Convalescent Care Unit
- Reports to be submitted to the Occupational Health/Infection Prevention & Control Practitioner.

Specifications:

- · Responsible individual with a mature appreciation of confidentiality
- Comfortable working independently
- High level of initiative
- Must have good knowledge of the hospital layout
- · Complete on-line training and one-on-one training for being a hand hygiene auditor
- Surge on-line Leaning for volunteers to be kept up to date
- Current criminal background check required



Interim Long-Term Care / Continuing Care Unit Volunteer

Primary Role:

Provide general support to patients, helping to improve their hospital stay.

Key Responsibilities:

- Help serve meals to residents and assist with cleanup as per protocol
- Assist staff with activities for the residents by helping and encouraging residents to participate
- Visit with residents one-on-one to provide social interaction, engage them in conversation, offer to play cards or board games
- Improve their hospital experience
- Take residents out of the unit for a change of scenery as allowed by staff

Specifications:

- Responsible individual with a mature appreciation of confidentiality
- Strong communication skills and interpersonal skills
- Positive, caring, compassionate and non-judgmental attitude
- High level of initiative
- Comfortable working with residents
- Ability to remain calm and use sound judgment with residents who may be suffering from high levels of stress
- Current Vulnerable Sector check required
- Keep Surge Learning (online training) up to date, annually

** Note: volunteers are not permitted to transfer residents from one surface to another, accompany any resident who requires assistance walking, or provide any attendant/personal support care

Roles:

There are two roles in ILTC unit for volunteers (see below). A volunteer might choose to be both or one or the other.

- ILTC Volunteer has specific duties (e.g. food services) trained by a member of the Auxiliary originally trained by KDH staff using the Train the Trainer Model and whose calendar is set in consultation with the KDH Activation Coordinator.
- 2. ILTC Activation Volunteer works directly with KDH Activation Coordinator (AC); i.e., trained by the KDH AC and whose calendar is set directly with the KDH AC.



Gift Shop & Coffee Bar Volunteer

Primary Role:

Serve customers food and drinks as ordered and assist customers with gift items.

Key Responsibilities:

- Maintain a clean and organized environment as per protocol
- Re-stock items as needed/delivered
- Improve patient experience
- Help patients/visitors with way-finding as needed
- Take payments

Specifications:

- Responsible individual with a mature appreciation of confidentiality
- Friendly and courteous individual with customer service mindset
- Strong organizational and communication skills
- High level of initiative and commitment to punctuality
- Ability to operate a cash register and Interact machine
- Ability to balance cash float at end of shift
- Understand the necessity to keep area clean and follow Health Regulation guidelines
- Current Vulnerable Sector check required
- Keep Surge Learning (online training) up to date, annually



Pastoral Care Volunteer

Primary Role:

Provide spiritual care for patients in a non-denominational manner.

Key Responsibilities:

- Inquire with the head nurse in M&S regarding any requests for a pastoral care visit
- Introduce yourself to residents in the ILTC/CC unit to let them know that you're available for a pastoral care visit.
- Listen to and visit with patients and/or families and when requested to do so, pray with them.
- Assist with KDH Annual Memorial Service

Specifications:

- Responsible individual with a mature appreciation of confidentiality
- Strong communication skills, interpersonal skills and a positive attitude
- High level of initiative
- Complete pastoral care training
- Current Vulnerable Sector background check required
- Keep Surge Learning (online training) up to date, annually
